

Weekly Press Briefing Chambers and Registry N°10/2021 The Hague, 18/11/2021

Update

Welcome to the weekly press briefing of the Kosovo Specialist Chambers, where we aim to provide you with an update on the latest developments at the court and a look ahead at next week.

In the Salih Mustafa trial, the seventh witness testified on Wednesday and Thursday. The witness gave evidence on the exhumation of a body in Zllash/Zlaš. The witness has been testifying with protective measures, including the use of a pseudonym as well as face and voice distortion. The next hearing in this case is scheduled for Monday, 22 November.

As per the decision of the Pre-Trial Judge on 18 October 2021, the Specialist Prosecution on Tuesday filed a public redacted version of the corrected indictment in the Pjëter Shala case. The corrected indictment is available on our website in all three languages of the Court.

Over the course of this week and last, some of the defence in the Hashim Thaçi and co-accused case filed appeals against decisions of the Pre-Trial Judge on the form of the indictment and on alleged violations of certain constitutional rights. Court of Appeals Panels were assigned to decide on these appeals and their decisions will be issued in due course. The relevant filings are available on the KSC website.
