



Update

Welcome to the weekly press briefing of the Kosovo Specialist Chambers, where we aim to provide journalists with an update on the latest developments at the court, a look ahead at next week and the opportunity to ask questions.

The trial of Salih Mustafa resumed on Tuesday, 18 January, with the testimony of witness W04485, called by the Specialist Prosecutor's Office. The witness testified without protective measures. He gave evidence on Brigade 153 of the KLA, the BIA Unit, and more generally on the structure of the KLA in Llap Operational Zone. The witness completed his testimony on Wednesday, 19 January.

During the hearing on 19 January, the Presiding Judge of Trial Panel I also announced that the Panel will soon issue a decision setting out the next procedural steps in the Mustafa case. These steps will include the closing of the SPO case, which is envisioned for 4 February 2022, as well as the scheduling of a status conference planned for 17 or 18 February 2022, during which the next phase of the trial will be discussed with the SPO, the Defence and Victims' Counsel.

The case will resume on 25 January at 9:30 in the morning with the next witness.

In the case of Mr. Gucati and Mr. Haradinaj, the second witness called by the Haradinaj Defense completed his testimony on Friday, 14 January.

The next witness in this case is scheduled to start testimony tomorrow, 21 January. The hearing will begin at 9:30 in the morning.

In the Pjetër Shala case, the Defence and the Prosecution in a pre-trial hearing on Friday, 14 January, discussed issues concerning the disclosure process as well as next steps to be taken in this case.
