

Weekly Press Briefing Chambers and Registry N°45/2022 The Hague, 08/12/2022

UPDATE

Welcome to the weekly press briefing of the Kosovo Specialist Chambers, where we aim to provide journalists with an update on the latest developments at the court, and the opportunity to ask questions.

In the case of Mr Salih Mustafa, Trial Panel I on 6 December scheduled the pronouncement of the judgment in this case for Friday, 16 December at 9 am, exactly three months after the closing of the case.

The public will be able to follow the hearing in the three languages of the court, Albanian, Serbian and English either via the streaming function on the website with a delay, or from the public gallery. Please note that pre-registration is required to follow the hearing from the public gallery. In case you would like to pre-register, please send an email to PUBLIC@scp-ks.org.

On 1 and 2 December, the Court of Appeals Chamber held an appeal hearing in the case of Mr Gucati and Mr Haradinaj. During the hearing, the Defence and the Prosecution presented their arguments and Mr Gucati and Mr Haradinaj addressed the Appeals Panel. The Court of Appeals Panel will render its judgment in this case in due course.

Next week's press briefing will be held on Friday, 16 December after the pronouncement of the trial judgment in the Mustafa case. We will communicate the exact time on the live update on the website.

Next week's press briefing will be the last press briefing before the end of the year as the judicial recess starts the week after. The court remains functional during the judicial recess period and work continues across all sections of the KSC.
